FINANCIAL STATEMENTS for year ending 30 June 2021 Financial report as provided with the reading of Sue Darney's comments:

2021 was a difficult and unpredictable year due to Covid however Swimming Taranaki has done well to maintain a healthy financial position. Reserves remain intact and sufficient is held to meet all future employment obligations for the year ahead and ensure the continued operation of the entity. Tania has done an excellent job at obtaining funding from various community trusts up 32k on the previous year.

The Flannagan Cup has again been well supported by local business and has returned a net profit of \$5k. Affiliation fee income is down by \$1k and camps, clinics income down by \$8k. Camps and clinics were run differently due to Covid as day events.

Taranaki events and our other fundraiser Winter Champs income was down by \$5k due to a decision by the board to reduce fees in order to encourage swimmers who had been unable to return to the pool due to Covid. Further out of town entries were significantly down due to the uncertainty of travel. National and

representative expenditure ws up by \$27k (due to funding income). No medals or ribbons were purchased in the year as sufficient stock was held thereby reducing that expense. The administrator's laptop was replaced and is included in the asset schedule. The major changes above has meant excess income over expenditure of \$11,093, an improvement in last years loss of \$12,566.

I would like to acknowledge and thank all of the volunteers who have helped throughout the year, from poolside officiating, travelling away with teams, fundraising for clubs through to stepping into Club Committee and Board roles. For those of you new to the swimming world, it requires a significant input from parents, caregivers, friends to enable our children to progress through on their swimming pathways. In particular – a huge acknowledgement and appreciation of people like Cath Tippett, Rowan Williams, Margaret Higginson, Lisa Goble, Jo Wood, Maree Collins, Claire Dodunski, Allison Gadsby, Chris Drummond, Diane Cooper, Andrew Wood (and myself) – none of which have swimmers but are all so keen and happy to continue to help when called upon – we would be so lost without you all.

To both of our Swimming Taranaki Administrators in the last year Tania Stockman & Sasha Reid – you are superstars – I'm sure most people don't appreciate how much is involved in the Administrator Role, but you both respectively gave everything you could to help not only the board but our clubs and members alike. Do know that the work you put in is appreciated! Sasha we are sorry Covid messed with your plans for this year, I know how enthusiastic you were to learn and grow in the role and Tania we thank you for changing your mind and coming back (or was it that you missed us? (3)).

To our current Board Members, Lisa Goble, Kayanna Keenan, Donna Bouzaid, Jo Wood & Fiona Lacey – thank you so much for all you have done for Swimming Taranaki in this last season. I have really enjoyed strategizing and planning with you all, nutting out the problems along the way and celebrating our successes as a team. Each of you brings different strengths, knowledge and passion with you and I am glad I have had the opportunity to get to know and grow alongside all of you.

Achievements

Our 2021-2022 Season started off so excitingly with Zac Reid and Sue Southgate attending the Tokyo Olympics in July 2021 – I am sure everyone in the swimming community were tuned in and cheering – and although not all of us have had a direct impact on your swimming journey, we were all so proud & I'm sure there were a few of us that managed a bit of name dropping when the opportunity arose! Your tenacity and commitment Zac is a credit to you and a true inspiration to our up and coming swimmers, not only within our region but I'm sure across the country. Sport Taranaki also acknowledged both Zac and Sue for their continued commitment to and achievements within Swimming, with Zac receiving both the Senior Sportsman of the Year and Sportsperson of the Year Awards and Sue receiving the Coach of the Year Award.

We had 2 of our swimmers break New Zealand Records, with Callum Gordon breaking the NZ 14 Year Old Boys 50m Freestyle Record at NZ Secondary Schools in July 2021 and Zac Reid breaking the NZ Mens Open 800m Freestyle Record at the Tokyo Olympics also in July 2021.

And considering how disrupted the year was we also had 19 Individual Taranaki Records broken with Callum Gordon x 4, Anahera Martin x 3, Raiden Pinto x 1, Zac Reid x 1, Bella Wansbrough x 8 and Monique Wieruszowski x 2 – which shows how determined our swimmers are!

Current Board Objectives

The numbers of swimmers has been declining over the past few years, not only in Taranaki but throughout New Zealand and we recognise that we need to provide a good strong base for our swimmers to be able to have plenty of opportunities to compete – we also need to be able to cater to all levels of our swimmers within the region. It is vital that we support each other so that our swimmers get those opportunities – from our Learn to Swim members through to our Olympians (because we have one of those right now). As such the Board have been trying to implement an annual swimming plan to grow the swimming opportunities within the region to support both our swimmers and our member clubs alike. We hope everyone is on the same page and that all of you support each other at the interclub carnivals both Development Meets as well as the Designated Meets – the more clubs that attend these events the more enjoyable they are – along with the added bonus of helping the clubs with some much needed fundraising.

The Board are continuously trying to improve our programme – but with anything new, there will always be hiccups. And although we may not always get it right we do welcome feedback and suggestions for improvement moving forward – this is how we will get strong.

Future Proofing

It is crucial that we have a succession of parents stepping into key roles within the sport. It was disturbing to see how many parents of ex-swimmers are called on to enable our events to go ahead, without them we potentially would have had to cancel events. On this note – PLEASE – I urge you, if you have a child that is loving swimming and has a plan to continue with swimming then do take the next step, reach out to one of our Technical Committee -Cath, Rowan, Margaret, Daniel or Annett and get some training to become an official – WE NEED YOU!

I was also a little saddened on occasion to hear negative comments about the Board (only a couple to be fair), but when I look at the Board Members we have I can tell you that each and every one of these people are on the Board because they care and want to help grow and strengthen swimming within the region. If you do have an opinion, or ideas on how things could work better, then this tells me that you care and if you do care then please put that energy into a constructive, positive and meaningful way – JOIN THE BOARD – for us to be a strong region we need support from across the region and we need to work together as a region.

The Board Members are on a 3 Year rotation, so each year we have 2 members roll off which enables 2 new members to roll on – this is how the board is kept current, with a continuous stream of new people and fresh ideas and yet, surprisingly each year our Board struggles to find anyone that wants to take on this role – crucially, if we want to stay under the Swimming Taranaki umbrella – we need to have an active Board – if we don't, somewhere along the line, we could lose our Regional body and be forced to join another region – do we want this to happen?

I have another year on the Board and am really looking forward to the new season, hopefully we have most of the Covid restrictions behind us so we can enjoy a full and busy swimming season again. I look forward to attending our local events and supporting our clubs and swimmers over the coming year alongside you all.

Swimming Taranaki Inc For the year ended 30 June 2022

Basis of Preparation

Swimming Taranaki is an Incorporated Society. The entity has elected to apply PBE SFR-A (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not-For-Profit) on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual operating expenses equal to or less than \$2,000,000. All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The Performance Report is prepared under the assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

The entity is registered for GST. All amounts are stated exclusive of goods and services tax (GST) except for accounts payable and accounts receivable which are stated inclusive of GST.

Revenue

Revenue is recognised to the extent that it is probable that the economic benefit will flow to the society and revenue can be reliably measured. Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received. The following specific recognition criteria must be met before revenue is recognised. **Donations, fundraising and other similar revenue**

Donations are recognised as revenue upon receipt.

Grant revenue includes grants given by other charitable organisations, philanthropic organisations and businesses. Grant revenue is recognised when the conditions attached to the grant has been complied with. Where there are unfilled conditions attaching to the grant, the amount relating to the unfulfilled condition is recognised as a liability and released to income as the conditions are fulfilled.

Revenue from legacies and estates that satisfies the definition of an asset is recognised as revenue when it is probable that future economic benefits or service potential will flow to the entity, and the fair value can be measured reliably.

Interest Revenue

Interest revenue is recognised as it accrues, using the effective interest method.

Income Tax

Swimming Taranaki Inc is wholly exempt from New Zealand income tax having fully complied with all statutory conditions for these exemptions.

Bank Accounts and Cash

Bank accounts and cash in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits) with original maturities of 90 days or less.

Receivables

Receivables are stated at their estimated realisable value. Bad debts are written off in the year in which they are identified.

Plant, Property and Equipment



Plant, property and equipment are measured at cost less accumulated depreciation and any impairment losses. Cost included expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of the asset.

Going Concern

These financial statements have been prepared on the basis that the trust is a going concern.

Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in accounting policies during the financial year. Policies have been applied on a consistent basis with those of the previous reporting period.



Presidents Report 2021-2022

Well another year with some ups and downs, but it looks like things are getting into the rhythm of a new normal.

Financially the club is still in a good position but funds have reduced lately due to Covid restrictions in place and limiting some of the activities that we normally do. The organisations that provide us funding actually put a stop to funding as they were not getting money in due to Covid restrictions in place.

Our clubs nights, which include Highlands, Okato and Waitara, are continuing to be a success. We are getting around 35 – 50 swimmers taking part. Thanks to Fiona and Carol (BWF coaches) for encouraging swimmers that normally swim in Town to make the trip to Bell Block for this event.

The last 12 months of learn to swim has seen a mixture of ups and downs due to Covid and the ongoing rounds of illness hitting the children. BWF Clients have been very loyal to the programme. Due to disruptions the opportunity to have make up lessons was well received by all. We have seen swimmers attending club nights and through this positive experience, there will be a few new members to the club over the next few months. (From Donna Bouzaid)

Swimming New Zealand changed their guidelines on qualifications for meets by introducing Designated and Development meets. There are specific rules around these meets.

Development meets require a lot less officials and the times recorded can be used for local and regional meets. This has helped tremendously in alleviating pressure on local Taranaki events to provide the full set of officials for a local meet.

Designated meets however still require the full set of officials as these times can be used for qualifying at National meets.

Chairperson's Report 2021/22

A meeting was held on the 28th October 2021 to organise our upcoming season. We focused on what we "could do" rather than what we "could not do" within the parameters of the restrictions and limitations the Covid 19 settings brought. There was a limited number of people allowed into the grounds of the pool. Vaccine Passes were necessary for those over 12yrs, and the changing rooms were not to be used. We decided that we could offer a partial Learn to Swim programme for 8 yr olds and above (as they did not require a parent in the grounds) and for the level Advanced Beginners and above. Registrations were very few, 43. Fourteen of those children took part in our weekly learn to swim programme with low ratios for groups. Their progress was very good. The Squad groups continued to train both at the Okato Pools and at the Aquatic Centre with Fiona Lacey. A Saturday or Sunday morning session was also very beneficial to our Squad swimmers.

Our Club attended various meets such as the Summer Series, which was also hindered by compliance to the Covid restrictions. A group of 17 swimmers representing Okato took part in the Taranaki Champs in April. This was the first time we had participated since 2016. All swimmers gained PBs and some came away with numerous medals. This was a first time for all our Squad Swimmers, and it highlights the quality coaching and encouragement they receive from Fiona. We were extremely proud of every one of our team who gave their all. We are extremely grateful for Fiona's tireless input.

Training continued into the winter months at the Aquatic Centre, and again a group representing Okato entered the July Champs. Winter illnesses did affect the numbers participating in this event.
