## **Meet Conditions**

- 1. Swimmers from all regions may enter this meet. A maximum of two (2) visitors are permitted to swim in the finals (including timed finals) ie 2 out of the 24 places may be taken by visitors unless there are lanes available for additional visitor swimmers to take. Notwithstanding this, no more than 2 visitors may swim in an "A" final or the fastest heat of a timed finals. For the purposes of this meet the definition of a visitor swimmer is any swimmer not affiliated to Swimming Bay of Plenty, Swimming Hawkes Bay Poverty Bay, Swimming Taranaki or Swimming Waikato.
- 2. Age: as at Friday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2014.
- 3. Closing Date: for entries 8.00pm, Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2014 <u>late entries not accepted</u>
- 4. Qualifying Period: from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013 to 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2014.
- 5. **Entry fee**: \$9.00 per event, \$18.00 per relay team payable to 'Central Swimming Incorporated' with Fee Report. For payments by electronic banking our bank account details are **12-3134-0067191-00**
- 6. Fee Payment : to be paid by Friday 14th March 2014.

- 8. Club Recorders to assist with planning; please include names of officials that can assist at the meet (including role and session(s))
- 9. 'Proof of times': entry report (by name) to accompany file (when emailing) and a hardcopy for <u>all</u> postal entries.
- 10. **Qualifying Times:** All Swimmers to have met the stated qualifying times. If a swimmer qualifies for only **one(1) event**, they may enter **one (1) other unqualified event limited to : 50m, 100m or 200m only.**
- 11. No Time (NT) will not be accepted.
- **12. Entry Times:** Converted times can be used.
- 13. Session 6 will commence approximately 90 minutes (TBC) after the completion of Session 5.
- 14. Scratchings/withdrawals: are required for Timed Finals & Finals only:
- Withdrawals from Finals to be advised to control within 30 mins of the heat results being posted
- Finalists are deemed to include the first 2 reserves
- Withdrawals from <u>Timed Finals</u> to be advised to control **45 mins before the** <u>start</u> of the session in which the first heat of the timed final will be swum.
- Relays: Teams must be confirmed to Control 45 mins before the start of the session in which they are to be swum.
- A Doctor's certificate is required for refunds AND subject to acceptance by the Meet Director.
- Fees for Withdrawals and Protests will apply and are as follows :
  - Failure to scratch within stipulated time frame: \$50.00 (payable on the day)
  - Protest fee: \$50.00
- Protests: SNZ Protest rules will apply.

### 15. Events

- All Events: Heats, AWD Finals, A, B & C Finals & Timed Finals will be swum as stated in the programme
- Heats will be swum as mixed age group separate male & female seeded on time & swum slowest to fastest.
- The slowest heats of the 800m and 1500m free events will be swum in the morning sessions
- Age Group Winners will be awarded from the Heat swims only
- <u>Finals</u> will be swum as A, B & C Finals, fastest 24 males & 24 females (regardless of age) starting with the 'A' final subject to the following conditions:
  - i. A minimum of 24 swimmers are required in an event for A , B and C finals to be run, otherwise
  - ii. The event reverts to an A and B Final requiring a minimum of 16 swimmers.
  - iii. If less than 16 swimmers then only an A Final will be run.
- Meet organisers reserve the right to combine any heat, timed final or final where necessary

#### 16. Awards

- Heats : <u>'Central Swimming Age Group Medals</u> will be awarded to **1**<sup>st</sup>, **2**<sup>nd</sup>, **& 3**<sup>rd</sup> Male and Female for the following age groups: **13**, **14**, **15**, **16**, **17/O**. Ribbons will be awarded to visitor swimmers who finish **1**<sup>st</sup>, **2**<sup>nd</sup> or **3**<sup>rd</sup> in their respective age group.
- Open 'Central Swimming' Medals awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Male & Female in the 'A' Final and 4<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> placegetters to receive ribbons. Ribbons will be awarded to visitor swimmers who finish 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in an "A" final.
- Relays: All swimmers must have entered and be competing in the Central Swimming Long Course Championships to be eligible to compete in a Relay Team. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> placegetters will receive medals.
- 17. A **\$100 T3 Voucher** will be awarded for each stroke to the top Male and Female Stroke Champion of the meet. FINA Points will be used to calculate winners.
- 18. A \$200 T3 Voucher will be awarded to the highest overall FINA point's scorers for both female and male.
- 19. **Poolside Officials:** We shall endeavour to provide the necessary number of officials, however the number on pool-deck may be more or less than that stated by Swimming NZ depending on availability of officials on the day.
- 20. Starts: are over the top for Heats & Timed Finals in the morning sessions only
- 21. **AWD:** See over-page details for AWD meet conditions.
- 22. **Electronic Timing:** will be used at these championships

## **AWD Conditions**

#### **BACKGROUND**

These Championships are a key event for our AWD athletes, many of whom are aiming to qualify for the 2014 Commonwealth Games to be held in Glasgow, Scotland.

#### **AWD FINALS**

50m Freestyle 100m Freestyle 100m Backstroke 100m Breaststroke 50m Butterfly 200m Individual Medley 400m Freestyle

#### **AWD RULES**

AWD shall swim their heats as part of the able-bodied programme.

AWD must register an official time in the heat swims to qualifying for the AWD finals.

All AWD finals shall be swum as a mixed age group and classification events.

1 set of medals (gold, silver, bronze) shall be awarded per AWD final.

Medals and placing's shall be determined based on the competitors' results in comparison to their relevant world record in their respective classification. This shall mean the competitor who achieves the lowest percentage of their own relevant world record (ie: the closest to their relevant world record) will be placed first, and so forth.

In addition, AWD can enter and swim in the heats of events that do not have AWD finals.

#### **ENTRY**

Competitors must hold at a minimum a provisional level classification (obtained through Paralympics NZ).

A section for this should be included on the entry forms.

There shall be no qualifying standards for competitors to compete in the AWD events. AWD are required to enter through their swim club.
