member level across the region. The problem is that there are way more events than there are funders available to us. Please rest assured that we are trying our best. I often hear people offer up names of trusts and other funding options but each organisation has its own priorities and areas of gifting, not always sports or Taranaki. At this stage we have 7 options (who give varying amounts from \$1,000 - \$15,000) to apply for funding and 15 events to apply for, I am able to combine some but of course this means distributing the money over more people.

National events and regional events are our priorities, along with my wages, I would love to be able to do this from the kindness of my heart, but I can't! We also have the issue of the impending changes to the Gaming Act which will decrease the amount of funds available. I have already talked to a couple of funders that have warned that amounts will decrease and also the things that we can apply for will lessen. I will keep trying my best but please do not take any funding for granted, it is never a given and *always a bonus*.
