Policy: **Competition**

Title: **Taranaki Club Relay Championships**

Objective: **Taranaki will host an annual Long Course Club Relay Championship to be held in New Plymouth or Hawera.**

Operational

1. The venue club will have at least one team competing in the championships or venue may be changed.
2. Medals/ribbons and trophies will be presented at the ST annual prizegiving and awards. Trophies will be recalled to be engraved.
3. Event will be held between February-July.

Meet Rules

1. All swimmers must be financial competitive or club members of a Swimming New Zealand affiliated Swimming Club.
2. Only Taranaki clubs may contest the trophies.
3. Age as at the first day of the Meet.
4. No late entries will be accepted
5. Ribbons shall be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd Male and Female teams.
6. Entries close with the Regional Administrator before the meet begins.
7. Entries are submitted by Club recorders via TM Files to taranakiswimming@gmail.com
8. Entry fee payment options are either by online banking or posted to Swimming Taranaki **before** the commencement of the meet.
9. Relay entries must have team names when submitting entries, if more than one team entered in an event label them A, B, C... and place the 'A' team as your expected fastest.
10. The Swimming New Zealand Withdrawal Rule will apply.
11. Each club shall appoint one team manager who will deal with all scratchings, protests, collection of disqualification slips, and attend any managers' meetings. This person will also ensure that all club members adhere to the rules of the meet.
12. The Durning Age Group Relay teams shall consist of one boy and one girl in each of the following age groups: 9 years and under, 10-11 years, 12-13 years, 14-15 years. Swimmers must swim in their correct age groups. Age will be determined on the **day of the relay**. The relay will be swum youngest to oldest age groups, with the boy swimming first in each age group.
13. Relays – A club can combine with another who cannot field a complete relay team in each category. A club who can field a team cannot have members join another mixed club team. Mixed club teams are not eligible for points but eligible for medals.
